- ◆ An additional day in January 2022 for a visit to the General Assembly and legislators representing Greater Williamsburg.
- ◆ Class Debrief and Graduation: May 19, 2022.
- ◆ A class project that will require additional hours outside scheduled class meetings - anticipated to be 40-60 additional hours depending on the nature of the project
